Carbon Credits FAQ's

What are carbon credits?

Carbon credits are like "climate-friendly permits" that allow someone to release a certain amount of carbon dioxide (CO2) into the atmosphere while compensating those emissions by funding projects that capture or reduce those CO2 emissions, or to compensate for emissions by funding projects that reduce emissions elsewhere. Think of them as a way to "balance" your environmental impact by investing in climate action.

How do they work?



They can be used in a few ways:

1) TO OFFSET EMISSIONS

Businesses can buy carbon credits to compensate for the emissions they produce, essentially "balancing out" their environmental impact.

2) IN REGULATED MARKETS

Governments may set limits on emissions, and businesses need to acquire enough credits to meet those limits.

Why are they used?

They provide an incentive for companies to reduce their emissions and contribute to a more sustainable future.

Where do they come from?

Carbon credits are issued by projects that reduce or remove emissions, such as:

RENEWABLE ENERGY PROJECTS

Switching from fossil fuels to renewable sources like solar or wind.

FORESTRY AND CONSERVATION PROJECTS

Protecting or planting trees to absorb CO2 from the atmosphere.

GREENHOUSE GAS CAPTURE

Technologies that capture and store CO2 emissions.












What Does This Mean to Kaska?
